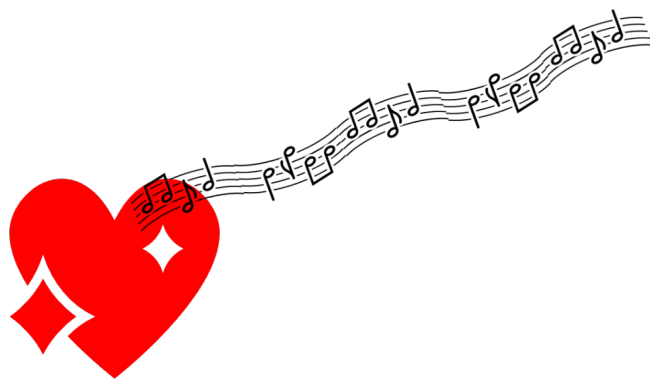

Inland Harmony Chorus


